## DIGITAL IMAGE RULES Revised August 4, 2017

- 1. During the 2016-2017 competition year, Digital Image Salons will be held on the first club meeting of every month, October through May.
- 2. A maximum of two (2) digital images may be entered in each salon.
- 3. Categories are assigned for each salon. Submitted digital images must be in the designated category.
- 4. All digital image entrants will compete in one class.
- 5. Digital images must be submitted in sRGB color space.
- Beginning with the 2017-18 competition year, digital images must be sized to 1920 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high, with a maximum file size of 1-Megabyte or less.
- Images must be submitted in .JPG format with 10, 11, or 12 compression to achieve a maximum size of 1-Megabyte or less. Occasionally, more compression may be needed. The Digital Competition Chairman will resize images as needed for other club uses, such as the website or newsletter.
- 8. Images must be emailed to the Digital Chairman (SPCCDigitalChair@aol.com) by each contest deadline. Images may also be submitted on a Flash Drive or CD at any SPCC meeting.
- 9. Images must be identified with a Title, Club Member Number, and YY-MM of the competition. For example: Lonesome Tree-SN045-17-10.jpg
- 10. Because the "truth", or "authenticity" of certain images is important: Nature, Photojournalism and Photo-Travel images allow only limited use of Photoshop. See Page 2-4 for rules.
- 11. Do not insert titles, maker's names or any identifying marks over the image.
- 12. Digital Image Salons will use the same scoring system and award structure as Monochrome Print and Color Print Salons.
- 13. Images will be kept by the Digital Chairman for re-entry in our end-of-year competition.
- 14. After the Annual Banquet, the Digital Chair will delete all members' files from his/her hard drive. The winning images will be posted on the club website.
- 15. SPCC rules specify that the Club's Digital Projector or Laptop Computer will not be loaned to anyone for personal use.
